2021/22 Suzuki Charter School 3 Phase Re-Entry Plans

* Alberta Education will provide school jurisdictions with guidance on school re-entry for 2021/22 school year which will guide any necessary adjustments to our Suzuki Charter School (SCS) school re-entry plans.

2021/22 SCS school re-entry plans include current Alberta Education guidance and best practises that we intend to continue as they support student and staff safety, community health and wellness, and effective school operations.

SCS School Re-Entry Plans and Best Practises*

- Parents will use the Pre-Screening COVID-19 Checklist and keep students home if symptomatic.
- Parents/Guardians will drop off and pick up students outside in designated zones.
- Parent/Guardian access to the school will be limited to out-of-school care pick-up.
- Students will wear masks and practise hand hygiene, physical distancing, and respiratory etiquette.
- Educational activities may be altered to meet regulations i.e., suspension of wind instrument playing and singing, resource sharing, physical distancing, field trips, assemblies, and other school events.
- Homeroom cohorts will be maintained as much as possible and foot traffic will be limited within the school.
- Enhanced cleaning and disinfecting will continue.

When Gov't Guidance Changes, Best Practises Continue

- Parents/Guardians will keep students home if symptomatic.
- Parents/Guardians will drop off and pick up students outside in designated zones.
- Parent/Guardian access to the school may include teacher-coordinated volunteer activities during instructional hours.
- · Students will practise hand hygiene and respiratory etiquette.
- Educational activities may be altered to meet regulations and best practises
- · Grade level cohorts will be maintained as much as possible.
- Cleaning and disinfecting will continue to adhere to best practises.

When Gov't Restrictions are Lifted, Best Practises Continue

- Parents/Guardians will keep students home if symptomatic.
- Parents/Guardians will drop off and pick up students outside in designated zones.
- Parent/Guardian access to the school may include teacher-coordinated volunteer activities during
 instructional hours, and school events including assemblies, celebrations, workshops, and meetings.
- Students will practise hand hygiene and respiratory etiquette.
- All educational activities resume to adhere to best practises i.e., assemblies, sports, and other events.
- · Grade level cohorts and multi-age cross-classroom activities resume i.e., reading buddies, mentorship etc.
- Cleaning and disinfecting will continue to adhere to best practises.
