Suzuki Charter Parent School Council held 8 meetings during the 2018/19 school year, alternating between morning and evening meetings. The Council welcomed a new vice-chair and 2 co-secretaries and saw increases in attendance at several meetings. We were pleased to see new Suzuki families also attend regularly.

Highlights:

- APEGA Science Night was once again held with a very large attendance. There were many geologists in attendance this year.
- Parent Council chair and parent volunteers ran the 3rd year of the monthlong literacy program with grades 3-6. National Novel Writing Month took place in November 2018 with many students, staff and parents participating to write and meet a word goal of their choosing. At the beginning of the month, one of the parents and one of the students were invited to give an interview about NaNoWriMo on the CBC Radio Edmonton morning show. They also returned for a follow up interview at the end of the month. The links to both interviews are listed below. 2 Write-In evenings were hosted at the school. Both were very well attended. SCS's 3rd Young Writer's Program book featuring excerpts of students, staff, and parents was laid out and awaited printing to be available at the beginning of the 2019-20 school year. We are hoping to incorporate the classroom aspects of the YWP into the Suzuki NaNoWriMo experience next year.
- The Alberta School Council Association held a workshop for Parent Council in December that focused on the Purpose of School Councils and was well attended.
- In January another Math workshop was held Box cars and One-Eyed Jacks.
- In March, Parent Council hosted an internet safety workshop. This was very well attended and supplied a lot of pertinent information for parents.
 The workshop was highly appreciated, and recommendations were made to make this a yearly event.
- Parent Council created and presented picture frames with a music quote for the music faculty. We also created hand-crafted appreciation gifts for the teaching faculty.

- Members gathered parent volunteers, and organized the End-of-the-Year Community BBQ.
- Throughout the year, parents provided discussion and feedback on a variety of school topics including: Winspear concert, silent auction, evening family events, winter concert, fundraising, budgeting, and increasing parent involvement. Traffic flow was a continued concern brought up by parents.
