OUR SCHOOL REALITY

Past four years- declining funding, reserves

TAAPCS - Provincial Leadership

Limitations on student enrollment

Limited access to capital improvements

GOOD NEWS BUDGET

Charter schools currently enrol 1.5 percent of the provinces K – 12 population and receive 1.2 per cent of education operating funds.

New budget:

Capital funding for expansion

Equity funding

CRITICISMS OF CHARTERS

Poorly substantiated claims that Charters are private, elite, charge tuition, have unfair enrollment practices (no special needs), are not accessible and take from public education.






Comparing Funding by School Authority


